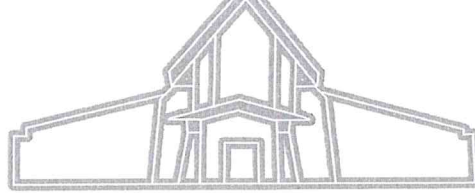


St. Mary + Magdalen
