

This week's gospel is the introduction to the Sermon on the Mount, which begins with the beatitudes, or the qualities one is to have in the kingdom of God.

Oftentimes we take each of these virtues as piecemeal, but we are supposed to develop all of them. One cannot say they will be meek but not pure in heart, or hunger and thirst for righteousness, but don't want to be a peacemaker. Indeed, the structure in which Matthew wrote could be read as:

Blessed are the poor in spirit and mourn, and who are meek and hunger and thirst for righteousness and are merciful, are pure in heart and a peacemaker, because the kingdom of heaven will be theirs and they will be comforted, they will inherit the earth and be filled. They will be shown mercy and see God and will be called children of God.

I love this reading because it gives us the image of what to strive for, what virtues to build.

God asks us to walk in his ways, but he doesn't leave us to do it alone. He not only teaches us in scripture but in the actions of his own Son, Jesus. The music I chose reflects that desire to continual conversion, asking God to show us the way, and in turn, turning around and sharing that light we receive from God with the world.
