Dear Friends in Christ,

I have heard from many of you who long to come back to Mass and to receive the Eucharist. However, you do not feel comfortable as COVID cases continue to accelerate in our region. In order to make Mass accessible to as many as possible, every pastor is now required to create a socially distanced section in their church by this weekend, January 22/23, if they do not have one yet. Each pastor may determine the best way to indicate this section in the church. Parishioners are required to wear masks in the sociallydistanced section. This directive is in effect until February 28, upon which time it will be re-evaluated. Models predict that Michigan may be through the worst of this latest surge at that point. Of course, parishioners are strongly encouraged to wear a mask in other areas of the church and at all in person meetings held on church grounds. I recognize that many of our pastors and their staffs have taken extra steps to protect and care for parishioners during this pandemic. I hope you are ready to be welcomed back, to be safe, to be fed, to be home.

Homebound Ministry

"Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light for my path" (Ps 119: 109)

Hello everyone,

Recently, I visited a homebound individual whose sharing about her faith filled me with joy. She admitted that her spiritual life has been greatly nurtured thanks to the "Bible In a Year" program. Reading the Scriptures is her most favorite duty. Yet sometimes she shows her concern as she reads the story of Israel in the Old Testament: "It is hard to understand why the Israelites kept committing the same sin over and over while worshiping the false gods. To ease her puzzlement, I told her that I feel very much like these Israelites because every time I go to confession, I tell the priest the same mistakes I have made. Saint Paul assures me: "What I do, I do not understand. For I do not do what I want, but I do what I hate (Romans 7:15). The Bible stories are not old-fashioned but relevant and refreshing. Indeed, God's Word is the Living Word. He is still speaking to us through the Bible. We are challenged to change our lives by living out our faith.

"The Bible in a Year" by Father Mike Schmitz is the most popular program of reading the Bible. Fr. Schmitz's purpose is to help people intensify their reading of the Holy Bible daily to obtain the goal of finishing the Bible in a year. Each day, he offers 20-25 minutes of Scripture reading, giving some reflection and prayers. Visit website https:// bibleinayear.fireside.fm/ if you would like to read and pray with the Bible daily.

This weekend, as we celebrate the Lunar New Year, I recall a beautiful Vietnamese Catholic tradition in which each family and individual picks one biblical verse as God's message for them and their family to live the entire year. May the Word of God guide all our thoughts, words, and actions.

In this bulletin, I'd like to ask all parents of middle schoolers and high schoolers to encourage your students to participate! Our high school students lead this retreat for the benefit of our middle schoolers. Most of our high school leaders are leaders because they loved being middle school participants!

Over the course of two days (Friday night to Sunday morning), the middle schoolers and high schoolers watch skits by our Core Team, listen to witness talks, engage in small conversations in share groups, jump around at SONG TIME!, play games, and eat awesome food. Middle schoolers are invited to engage with the retreat theme and with their faith throughout the weekend. It's our biggest youth ministry event at St. Mary Magdalen and, for many of our students, the most exciting. Many of our young adults come back specifically to help out at this event, which I believe is a testament to its importance.
