

Homebound Ministry

Hello everyone,

This Sunday is Divine
Mercy Sunday. Pope John Paul II
established this Feast of Mercy in
2000 at the canonization of St.
Faustina Kowalska, the one who
received visions from Jesus. Her
mission is to spread the message of
God's mercy and forgiveness
through the Image of Divine Mercy
which originated from a vision she
had on Feb. 22, 1931. Saint Faustina
recorded the event in her Diary,
which she kept at the Lord's request.
She wrote:



"In the evening, when I was in my cell, I saw the Lord Jesus clothed in a white garment. One hand [was] raised in the gesture of blessing; the other was touching the garment at the breast. From beneath the garment, slightly drawn aside at the breast, there were emanating two large rays, one red, the other pale. In silence I kept my gaze fixed on the Lord; my soul was struck with awe, but also with great joy. After a while, Jesus said to me, "Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the signature: Jesus, I trust in You. I desire that this image be venerated, first in your chapel, and [then] throughout the world" (Diary, 47).

St. Faustina explained: "The pale ray stands for the Water which makes souls righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is the life of souls". We might recall when Jesus died on the cross, a soldier pierced Christ's side with his spear; blood and water flowed from it. These two rays signify the sacraments of mercy (Baptism and Penance), and the Eucharist. The Eucharist is the blood of souls, bringing nourishment for our spiritual journey. The sacraments of Baptism and Penance are the sacraments when our souls are washed clean. (Source: The Divine Mercy webpage)

Please join us in celebrating this special Feast Day of our Lord's Divine Mercy which will be held at **3pm in the chapel**, **April 24**th. We pray that His merciful love will fill our hearts, our family, our country and the whole world.

Hello everyone!

Happy second Sunday of Easter, also known as Divine Mercy Sunday or the Feast of Divine Mercy. For this bulletin article, I was reading up on this celebration and contemplating the diary entries of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, who popularized this devotion. I found myself struck by diary 742 in particular, which I think dovetails nicely with our first reading. Here is the diary entry:

"Yes, the first Sunday after Easter is the Feast of Mercy, but there must also be deeds of mercy, which are to arise out of love for Me. You are to show mercy to our neighbors always and everywhere. You must not shrink from this or try to absolve yourself from it."

In our first reading, we see a glimpse of what this looks like. We hear about the "signs and wonders" done by the apostles, and I'm personally struck by the image that we get at the end, of the crowds gathering and "bringing the sick and all those disturbed by unclean spirits." We're told that they're all cured, and I think this gives us a clear image of what it looks like to perform the deeds written about in the diary entry.

And imagine what a beautiful, peaceful world we would have if all of us took this entry to heart and showed mercy to their neighbors, "always and everywhere." It would be a herculean effort, but the rewards would be worth it. So how can we strive to show mercy and to gets ourselves a little closer to this ideal world in this upcoming week? Peace.
