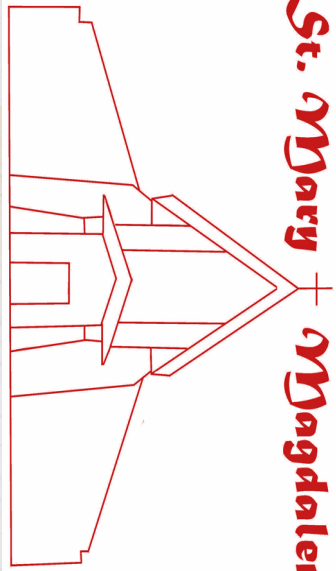
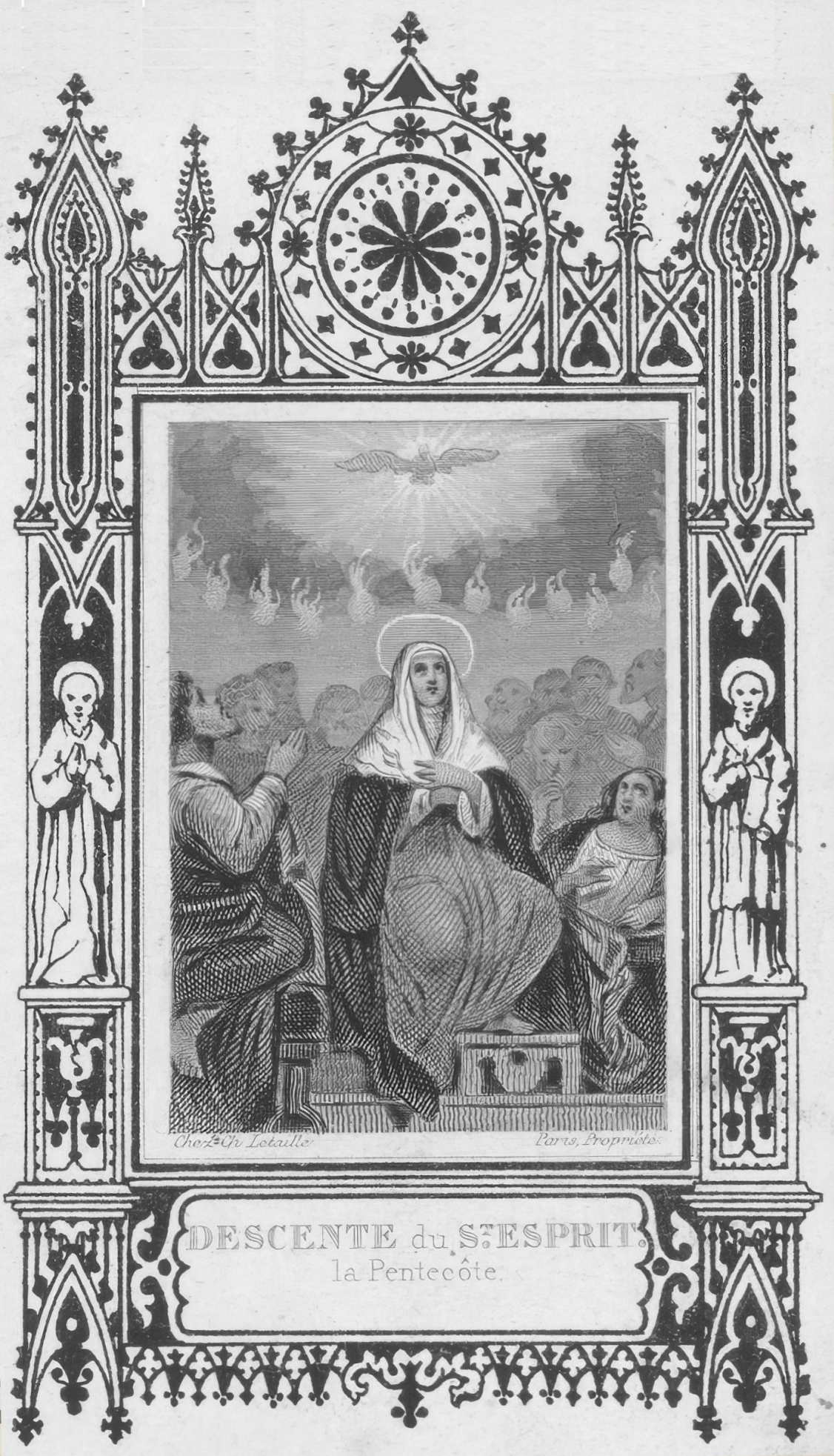

Homebound Ministry

Hello everyone,

The feast of Pentecost marks the end of the Easter season and the transition to ordinary time. We are also in the last days of May, the month of Mary. I want to take a moment to reflect on Mary as a model of living the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Firstly, Mary exemplifies her openness to the working of the Holy Spirit. When the Angel Gabriel announces that she would conceive and bear a child by the power of the Holy Spirit, Mary humbly embraced God's plan with her "Fiat". This intimate union between Mary and the Holy Spirit led to the conception of Jesus, earning her the title of the "Spouse of the Holy Spirit."

Secondly, Mary teaches us how to live out the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Upon receiving Jesus into her womb through the Holy Spirit, Mary's immediate instinct was to reach out and assist her cousin Elizabeth. This act of selflessness and charity exemplifies the fruits of the Holy Spirit, such as love, kindness, and generosity. Mary's visitation to Elizabeth reminds us to utilize the gifts bestowed upon us by the Holy Spirit to serve and support others in their time of need.

Lastly, Mary teaches us the importance of prayer and waiting for the Holy Spirit. After Jesus' Ascension, Mary joined the disciples and believers in Jerusalem, dedicating herself to prayer. Her presence encouraged the community to persevere in prayer and to prepare for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost.

Let us join together in prayer with our Mother Mary, asking for the Holy Spirit to guide and empower us in our lives. Wishing you a blessed Pentecost!

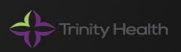
