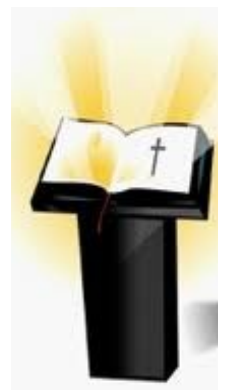

Homebound Ministry

Hello everyone,

This Sunday, we celebrate the solemnity of the Holy Trinity, the unfathomable mystery of our faith. This reminds me of a professor of my Holy Trinity class, asking his students on the first day of class: Do you understand why there is one God but three persons? No, all students respond. The professor continues: "That is why you take this class. Even after this class, you still do not understand the Holy Trinity, however, you will know why we humans cannot understand. It is simply a mystery that our limited thoughts and words cannot explain fully".

Indeed, we believe one God in Three Divine Persons as our Lord Jesus has revealed to us when sending out his disciples: "*Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit*" (Mt 28:19). At each Sunday and solemnity liturgy, when saying the Creed, we confess our faith in God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We glorify and praise the Holy Trinity in the Glory Be. Especially, we bless ourselves with the Cross in the name of the Blessed Trinity many times in our daily life.

More than what we believe and confess, we are blessed to share the Triune life. In His teaching, Jesus reveals his loving relationship with the Father and the Holy Spirit. Jesus is one with the Father and the Holy Spirit; He only seeks to please the Father and to listen to the Holy Spirit. He desires to bring us into this relationship as we love and follow his example of being obedient and docile to the Father and the Holy Spirit: "*Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him* (John 14:23)

Every time we make the sign of the Cross in the name of the Blessed Trinity, may the Triune God imprint His holy love in our hearts so that we might become like Him, always loving, self-giving and seeking happiness for others.
