



Homebound Ministry

Hello everyone,

If you go to the Cathedral of St. Andrew Church in our diocese, you might notice four statues of saints with four different skin colors: St. Martin de Porres, St. Kateri Tekakwitha, St. Andrew, and St. Agnes De Thanh Thi Le (in the left corner). In this brief article, I would like to share a little bit about the only Vietnamese woman saint, whose celebration is this Tuesday, July 12.

St. Agnes De was known as a wife and mother of six children. She carefully taught her children the catechism and the Christian way of life. During a time of harsh persecution, she always supported and welcomed priests to her house. She was put in prison while trying to hide a priest in her house on the morning of the Resurrection Sunday.

Despite the many kinds of suffering she endured in prison, as they demanded she deny her faith, St. Agnes De kept an optimistic attitude and stayed firm in her faith in God. When her daughter visited her, she sobbed when seeing her mother's shirt stained with blood. However, St. Agnes De comforted her daughter: "Don't cry, I'm wearing a rose shirt, I'm happy to suffer for the sake of Jesus". St. Agnes De died in prison after being tortured and beaten severely but persevered in her faith in God. She is a patron for all Catholic Vietnamese mothers.

No matter who we are, what vocation we live, we all are called to live a holy life in all circumstances of our life. May St. Agnes De intercede for us to follow her example of how to be faithful to God.

Music Ministry



Last week I discussed the process of planning for a wedding at St Mary Magdalen. This week I will go over what to do when planning a funeral. This information may be used to pre-plan your own funeral or a family member's funeral.

A funeral Mass will retain the same structure of the Mass, but with extra rites placed at the beginning and the end. The family or pre-planner may choose the readings (1st, Psalm, 2nd, and Gospel) and the hymns. Appropriate readings are found in *The Order of Christian Funerals*; we have condensed this information into our own funeral booklet here at the Church.

Hymns at a funeral are a sign of the faith of the deceased and the family, but also a comfort to those left behind. Hymns that highlight our Christian hope in the resurrection are extremely appropriate. Songs that are meaningful to the family, but not sacred in nature may be used at the visitation or the luncheon, but not at mass. (If we wouldn't sing them on Sunday, we can't use them at a funeral.) The St Mary Magdalen Funeral Booklet lists song suggestions for each part of the mass. Songs are used at the entrance, offertory, communion, *optional communion meditation*, Song of Farewell, and Recessional. The Song of Farewell is a specified text and cannot be replaced with a favored hymn.

At St Mary Magdalen, we have a small, dedicated group of singers that make up the Resurrection Choir. This group of people bring comfort and beauty through song at a difficult time in people's lives. In fact, the entire funeral liturgy is very beautiful to me. It is one of my favorite ministries as a liturgical musician. I consider it a great honor to contribute to this last act of faith and a family's goodbyes. If you have any questions regarding music or filling out the planning sheet for funerals, you may contact me or Laura in the office.
