Hello everyone,

July seems to go so fast; we are near the end of this month. We will enter the month of August very soon. First of all, let us join our Pope with his prayer’s intention for this month: “We pray for small and medium sized businesses; in the midst of economic and social crisis, may they find ways to continue operating, and serving their communities”.

In the first days of August, we will celebrate the feast of two great saints: Saint Alphonsus Liguori (8/1) and Saint John Vianney (8/4). They came from different countries and lived in different times. Moreover, both of them follow the same priestly vocation and the love for our Lord, Jesus Christ.

Saint Alphonsus is known as a holy bishop, a smart theologian of morality and a religious founder. Ministered in the role of the bishop of St. Agatha of the Goths in Italy, he reforms his diocese to focus on serving the poor, and to be faithful to Jesus’s teachings. He offers his talents to serve God in the field of morality. His many moral writings are used widely in the Church until now. He found the congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer. The followers in his spirituality are increasing and serving throughout the world.

Saint John Vianney is well-known as a holy and humble priest serving in a small village of Ars, France. He tirelessly encourages people to return to God, seek God’s grace and healing through the sacrament of reconciliation. He spends a lot of time, from 11 to 16 hours, hearing confessions for people from everywhere. He is the patron saint of the parish priests.

Through the intercession of St. Alphonsus and St. John Vianney, we pray for Father Peter and all priests and bishops through all the Churches. May God fill them with the grace of holiness and zeal to shepherd God’s people.

Sister Parish Update - St. Agnes de Dubois, Haiti

From their new pastor, Fr. Guivenks Clesias

I feel an unspeakable joy today to have the opportunity to introduce myself to you and to thank you for your support within the Parish of Sainte Agnès de Dubois. We will never stop leading you in our prayers because you are living stones for the construction of the Church of Christ.

My one and only goal is to follow Christ in the footsteps of Saint Montfort to serve the poor, the unfortunate and the vulnerable. I am ready to sacrifice myself for the development of the portion of people that God has entrusted to me.

I am Guivenks CLESIAS, smm born on October 8, 1985 in Dondon, a town located in the North department of Haiti. I am the sixth in a family of 10 children. I did my primary studies at Saint Viateur School in Dondon and my secondary studies with the Brothers of Christian Instruction of Cap-Haitien (FIC). I entered the Montfortians on September 29, 2011. After a period of postulancy, I entered philosophy at the Grande Séminaire Notre Dame. Then I left for France for the novitiate and I lived for a year. On my return, I continued my theological studies at the Center Inter-Institutes for Religious Formation (CIFOR) in Port-au-Prince. Finally, I was ordained deacon on September 15, 2019 and priest on December 26, 2020 by the laying on of hands by His Excellency Monsignor Max Le Roi Mésidor, Archbishop of Port-au-Prince.

After my priestly ordination, I was sent on a mission to the parish of Saint Louis Roi de France of Saint Louis du Nord diocese of Port-de-Paix and after a year as vicar I was sent to the parish of Sainte Agnès de Dubois. as pastor. I was installed on February 16, 2022 by my Provincial Superior, Reverend Father Jean Jacques Saint Louis, smm. Here is in a nutshell what I find necessary for my presentation.
