

We recently received a 2022 impact report for Kent County from Feeding American West Michigan. The following are some of the numbers from the report.

- ♦ There are 399 mobile pantries serving Kent county. Mobile food pantry cost \$307,625 and provide mobile pantries with 2,190,133 lbs of food equaling 1,825,111 meals.
- ♦ Number of household served by mobile pantries 37,496,
  - \* Individuals 131,852
  - Children 52,199,
  - \* Seniors 24,853
  - \* Veterans 3,453

Out of the top 10 mobile pantry partners, St Mary Magdalen came in at #5 with 86,603 lbs distributed. Thank you
