We furnish the supplies and bowls. You get to furnish your imagination. There will also be refreshments.



Hello everyone,

A few months ago, a friend of mine and I had a chance to attend a Buddhist funeral. Both of us did not understand much about their funeral traditions. After some research and study, I came to learn that Buddhism believes in reincarnation. Later, my friend confided how much she appreciates being Catholic and following Jesus and his teachings: "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." (John 3:16).

Our Catholic faith teaches us that this life on earth is just a temporary journey, anticipating the eternal life in heaven. When our life on earth comes to an end, we pass this fleeting world to the new life that God plans for us to share his kingdom in heaven, our true home, a place of no pain and sorrow.
