As the End of Year season of giving approaches, we are reminded of all the blessings in our lives: the gift of life itself, our loved ones, our faith, our God-gifted talents and strengths as well as our financial resources.

A special Thank You to everyone who continues to give through the use of the Benevolent Fund and the Maintenance Fund envelopes. Due to your generosity we have been able to help those in need in Haiti (Sister Parish—St. Agnes de Dubois) and in our local community through the monthly Food Truck (Feeding America). As our facilities continue to age, we are faced with multiple repairs and replacement costs in order to maintain the beautiful buildings and grounds of our faith home. Thank you again for all those who supported the kitchen drain pipe repairs to replace all of the old cast iron piping that had deteriorated!

Not to be the bearer of bad news; however, another critical piece of kitchen equipment is nearing the end of its life expectancy. Our Family Center dishwasher is 25 years old and is showing signs of failure. The short term fix requires replacing a \$700 electronic switch as well as a \$2,500 motor not including installation costs. The long term and better solution is to replace the dishwasher all together. The estimated cost for a new one is \$5,500.

If you are looking to make an end of year donation, please prayerfully discern if you would like to designate some of those funds towards the "New Dishwasher" project.
