

SPECIAL PROJECT—NEW DISHWASHER FOR KITCHEN

To date \$2,780 has been raised for the purchase of a new commercial kitchen dishwasher. The existing dishwasher was procured eight years ago and was purchased used. Unfortunately, we do not know exactly how old it is, but the estimate is that it is nearly 25 years old. The initial cost to repair the dishwasher was \$700 for an new electrical component and \$2,500 for a new motor. However, one estimate to replace with a new dishwasher is \$5,500. We are still working on getting at least one more estimate for a new replacement.

Thank you for your generous financial support of St. Mary Magdalen Parish! As our facilities continue to age, we strive to be the best stewards of the financial gifts entrusted to our care. Our goal is to purchase a new dishwasher that will last another 25 years! This will allow us to continue our wonderful hospitality ministries including: funeral receptions, wedding parties, Family Center events that need full kitchen usage, etc.

I've heard stories of a gunshot victim who was so severely wounded that there was a hospital employee mopping up the blood that they were losing. They survived. How about the child who was diagnosed at age 5 with acute lymphoblastic leukemia and is now 10 years old? You can become a silent hero by signing up for our January 15th blood drive.

We are hearing the different Christmas songs at this time of year, but do you know the meaning behind them? 12 Days of Christmas was written by Catholics in England as a catechism song to teach their children about the Christian faith. The song's "gifts" help remember the teachings of the faith.

"True Love" refers to God. "Me" refers to every Christian. The symbols mean the following:

- 1 Partridge in a Pear Tree = Jesus Christ
- 2 Turtle Doves = the Old & New Testaments
- 3 French Hens =Faith, Hope an Charity or the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit Trinity
- 4 Calling Birds = The Four Gospels
- 5 Golden Rings = The first Five Books of the Old Testament
- 6 Geese A Laying =The Six days of creation
- 7 Swans a Swimming =The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit (1Corinthians 12:8-10)
- 8 Maids a Milking = The eight Beatitudes (Matthew 5: 3-10)
- 9 Ladies Dancing = The Nine Fruits of the Holy Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23)
- 10 Lords a Leaping =The Ten commandments (Exodus 20)
- 11 Pipers Piping = Eleven Apostles, not Judas
- 12 Drummers Drumming = The Twelve Points of Doctrine in the Apostle's Creed.
