Family Car Talk

Today is Divine Mercy Sunday, a day when we remember that Jesus' love is bigger than every fear, mistake, or doubt. In the Gospel, Thomas struggles to believe that Jesus is alive. Instead of getting angry, Jesus gently shows Thomas his wounds and invites him to believe. Jesus meets Thomas right where he is—with kindness and mercy.

As you go home, talk about how Jesus shows mercy to your family when you struggle or doubt.

- B** When do you need Jesus to help you feel brave or calm?
- I** Thomas needed to see Jesus to believe. What helps you trust Jesus when something is hard?
- A** Divine Mercy means Jesus loves us even when we are confused or afraid. Where do you need his mercy most right now?
