



# FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT



Ezekiel 37:12-14 • Romans 8:8-11 • John 11:1-45

## Family Car Talk

Today we hear how God brings life where there once was none. In Ezekiel, God promises to open graves and fill his people with his Spirit. In the Gospel, Jesus raises his friend Lazarus from the dead, showing that his love is stronger than death. St. Paul tells us that the Holy Spirit brings life to our hearts.

As you go home, talk about how Jesus brings life and hope into your family.

Martha tells Jesus she believes he is the Son of God.

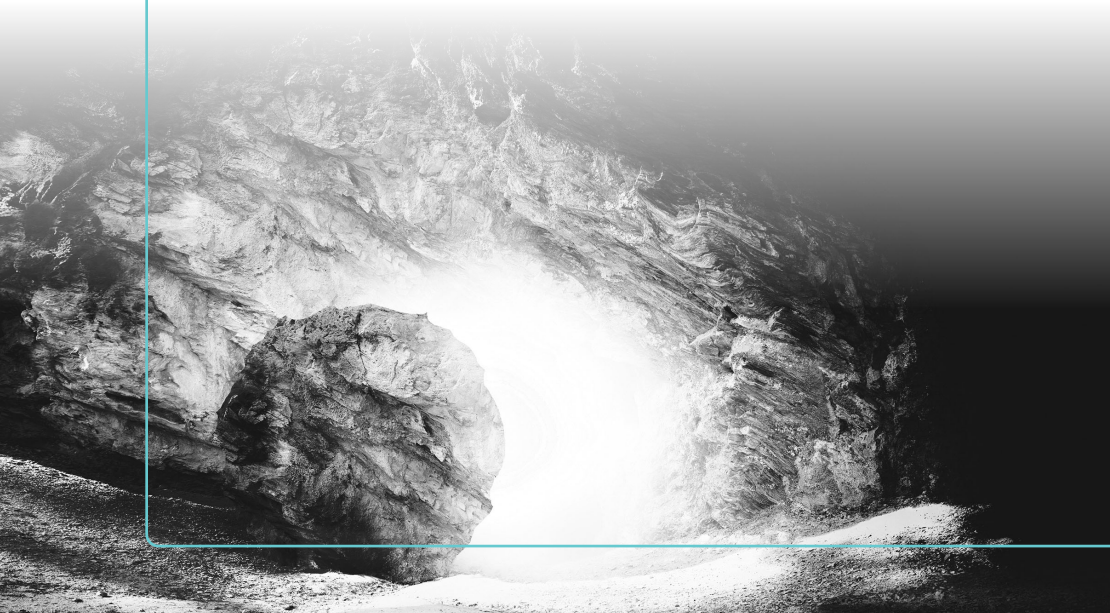
## Meaning:
