Palm Sunday begins with excitement as the crowds wave palm branches and welcome Jesus as their king! But today's readings also tell us about Jesus' great love shown in the Passion. He chooses to be humble, gentle, and obedient to God, even when it is very hard.

As your family enters Holy Week, think about how Jesus walks with you and how you can grow closer to him.

- I** Jesus was humble even when he was treated unfairly. When is it hard for you to be gentle or patient?
- A** Saint Paul tells us Jesus "emptied himself." What does it mean to give of yourself for others?
